The responsibility of the Parenting Coordinator is to assist parents by facilitating communication, education and dispute resolution. Parents with continuing disputes and chronic litigation about their children following separation and divorce present a difficult problem for courts, lawyers and mental health professionals. This process reduces re-litigation rates when high conflict is present thus protecting children from the adverse emotional impact of parental conflict.
